## A. Current CMP- Blue Sky Builders Rev 01 August 2020

- 1. Calthorpe Street Entrance Gate Usage- Along Calthorpe Street the logistics route for construction vehicles shows the use of the newly created vehicle entrance, this gate is on the NorthWest corner, this crossover and access route were created by the previous contractor prior to McAleer & Rushe's start on site.
- **2. Use of Phoenix Place Entrance** The plan does not show the use of Phoenix Place access gate to phase 3 construction works
- **3. Reversing Vehicles-** The logistics information does not include information about the reversing of large vehicles into the site entrance
- 4. No mention of Poweron's utility works on Phoenix Place

## **B.** Amendment Proposal

Calthorpe Street Entrance Gate Usage- The newly created entrance gate on Calthorpe
 Street has been set at height of the permanent end state laneway, the construction phase
 site formation level is c.800mm lower, meaning that this entrance cannot be used for the
 construction logistics.

McAleer & Rushe would propose to use the other entrance on Calthorpe Street to the Eastern Side, this entrance can be seen on the below drawing. (Diagram Appendix no.2)

This entrance & crossover was existing from Royal mail's use of the site, vehicles would be marshalled into the site as per the other entrances

- 2. Use of Phoenix Place Entrance- McAleer & Rushe require the use of the existing entrance on Phoenix Place to phase 3, this entrance was previously used by Royal Mail and would provide direct access to Block E construction, using this entrance would ease the quantity of vehicles required to use the entrance on Calthorpe Street and Farringdon Road.
- **3. Reversing Vehicles-** The logistics information does not include information about the reversing of vehicles into the site entrance. The approved CMP was not an accurate representation of the site internal layout, tower cranes and constraints.

There is not sufficient space within the site boundary to reverse and turn an artic & all rigid lorries, we are therefore required to reverse the larger vehicles into the site boundary, lorries will leave the site in forward gear.

All vehicle movement will be controlled by traffic marshals, ensuring that pedestrians do not enter the area that the vehicle is moving within, they will temporarily stop the flow of traffic and safely guide the vehicles into the site entrance.


**4.** Poweron have been carrying out utility connection works on Phoenix Place and are due to continue these works until the start of April. Through traffic routes are not achievable on Phoenix Place during these times.

McAleer & Rushe have amended their traffic management plan to accommodate the reversing of vehicles on Phoenix Place to access the entrance (Gate no.4) See appendix no.3 for extract from TMP.

As above, all reversing vehicles will be controlled by McAleer & Rushe traffic marshals.





Phoenix Place will be closed to through traffic as below drawing from JSM. However, we should be able to take deliveries into Gate 4. These deliveries MUST arrive from the Northern end of Phoenix Place, from the Calthorpe Road Junction.


If drivers attempt to approach from the Southern end of Phoenix Place they will meet the Road Closure and cannot reach the site.



Any vehicles which do arrive to Gate 4 from the Northernly direction should follow the traffic movements noted below. Drive forward past the site, as far as the road closure, then, under instruction of the traffic marshal, reverse into the site.

When leaving the site, the vehicle must turn Right, and exit driving in a northernly direction towards Calthorpe Street

#### Traffic Management

Poweron/UKPN continue their service connection works on Phoenix Place. Vehicle access to the road is closed during the works which is estimated to complete for the end of March 2022. Pedestrian through access is maintained, along with construction logistic traffic to Phase 2 & access for Royal Mail. Visitor access also maintained for The Postal Museum. Calthorpe Street and Farringdon Road will remain in use as the main logistics route for Phase 3.

#### Progress to Date

The following progress has been made since our last newsletter:

#### Phase 2:

- · Block D concrete frame complete
- · Block D scaffold now complete
- Block B windows installed to L6
- 1st fix fit-out works ongoing to L4
- Block C L4 concrete frame complete
- Brickwork ongoing to L2 of Block B

#### Phase 3:

- Foundation piling works now 70% complete
- L4 of Block F concrete frame complete
- Block E L1 concrete slab poured
